Candidates are encouraged to attend at least one meeting and one other event prior to seeking to join the organization. This is intended to ensure that the candidate has an understanding of the organization and its mission. You must keep your e-mail address current.

We have no dues. You must be willing to help with our annual awareness rally and other projects we have (year round) if you live in the area. Owing a motorcycle is NOT REQUIRED, but we do ride and all bikers are welcome (Must be at least 650cc and road worthy).
